Gold Creek Motors Gungahlin Service Department conducts free Community Auto Nights at Gold Creek Motors in Gungahlin every 2 months. They have now designed a new program for high school and college students as well as parents and teachers. They teach you how to correctly check your tyre pressures, change a flat tyre, care for your car, how to replace wiper blades, install globes, check oil levels and what oil to use etc. They also have a car set up on a hoist showing everybody underneath a vehicle and explaining how brakes etc work. Applications for the 2019 Charles Hawker Scholarships open on December 3, 2018 and close on January 4, 2019. An application form and further information about C.A.S. Hawker and the scholarship is available from www.hawkerscholarship.org.

Hawker Scholarships are valued at up to **\$60,000.00 over three years** for university study and are amongst the most generous privately funded residential scholarships available to Australian undergraduate and postgraduate students.

There are several scholarships awarded each year. The Trustees offer them to capable students largely based on personal qualities and demonstrated leadership as well as academic ability.

WANT TO GO TO UNI NEXT YEAR IN NSW OR ACT?

Do you know about the School Recommendation Scheme (SRS)?

SRS are one-way Universities or Tertiary Institutions make early offers of admission to current Australian Year 12 students who have applied for undergraduate admission through UAC. Unis and Tertiary Institutions use a range of selection criteria not just ATARs. Each Uni and Tertiary Institutions has their own policies on determining SRS eligibility. Fourteen Institutions are participating in the SRS in 2018:
