SAVER PLUS

Welcome back to the 2019 school year. I hope you all had an enjoyable holiday with family and friends.

Saver Plus is a free financial education program delivered by The Smith Family that can help families on lower incomes pay for school costs such as book packs, uniforms, laptops and excursions, by matching their savings, dollar for dollar, up to \$500.

People may be eligible to join Saver Plus if they meet all the following the criteria:

- be over 18 years old;
- have a Centrelink Health Care or Pensioner Concession card;
- be in receipt of an eligible Commonwealth social security benefit, allowance or payment (many Centrelink payments are eligible)
- have some regular income from work (themselves or their partner) including casual, part-time, full-time or seasonal employment; and
- have a child enrolled at school (or enrolled to start school) or attend vocational education themselves.
